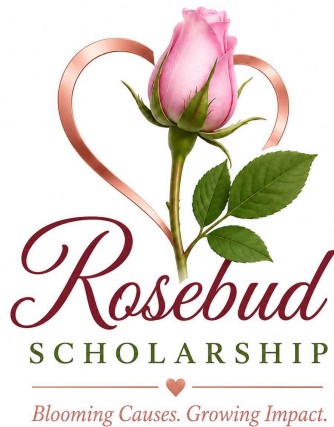




The Purpose

Award Recognition

At the official scholarship presentation, the organization agrees to have:

- Executive Director (or designee)
- At least one staff representative
- At least 2-3 Board Members (when reasonably available) present to accept the scholarship.
